



A Parking Violation is an offence against the Traffic Bylaw of the City of Charlottetown. As such it is treated like any other violation of law, which may be dealt with under other statutes such as the Highway Traffic Act, Liquor Control Act or Criminal Code.

On occasion errors such as; inappropriate signage or pavement markings, may occur which may question the validity of a parking violation. In these instances this form should be completed by the party raising the concern.

Once completed, the information contained will be investigated and a determination made with respect to the validity of the violation issued. In any case, the party completing the form will be contacted and advised further as to the status of the violation, within 72 hours.
